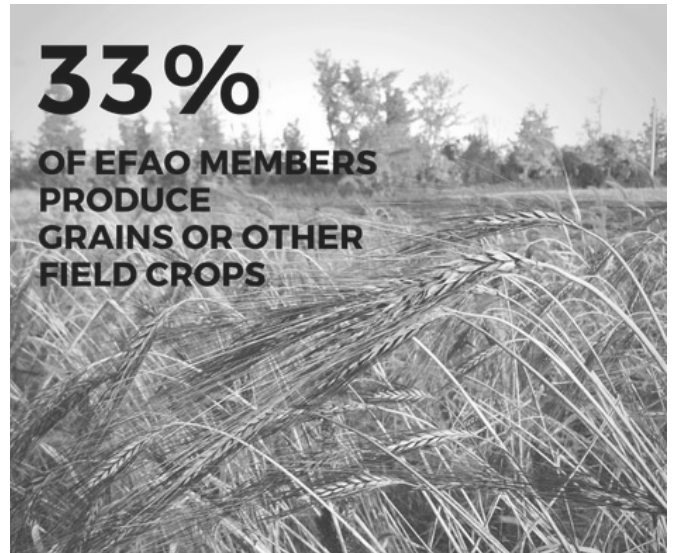

EFAO has over 500 members across Ontario:



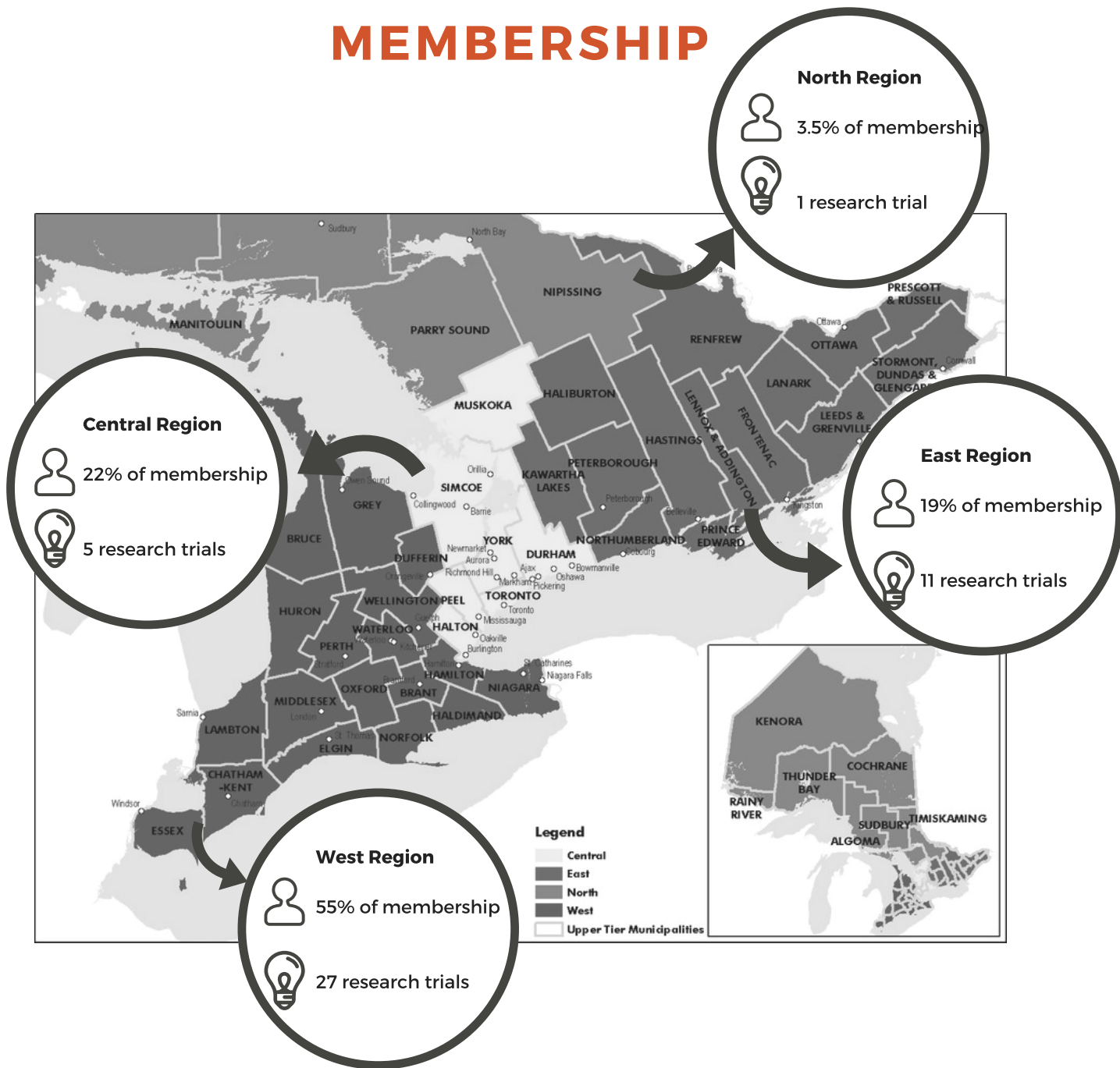
EFAO members have highly diversified farm operations, with half of all fruit & vegetable producers also selling animal products, and half of those farms producing field crops as well.
